## Wines for Summer:

Being in the wine business gives us the opportunity to try many really nice wines. Varietals we (or our customers) may overlook in the heat of the summer in search of the usual suspects Chardonnay or Sauvignon Blanc. We have examples of each of these by the glass at grapevine!! Stop in and try something different.

**Grüner Veltliner** - Grüner Veltliner is a variety of white wine grape widely grown primarily in Austria and widely also in the Czech Republic, but almost nowhere else. It has a reputation of being a particularly food-friendly wine. Citrus and peach flavors are apparent, with spicy notes of pepper and sometimes tobacco.

**Torrantes** - South America's best kept wine secret is no more. The Torrantes grape, grown principally in Argentina, is picking up steam with consumers looking for a great white wine. Most have become familiar with Argentina's great red grape, Malbec, and are now looking for something comparable in quality but better fitted for the fast approaching warm weather months. For many, Torrantes is the answer. Floral, citrusy and at times tropical, Torrantes is no longer just for the Argentines. It's a step up for you all Pinot Grigio drinkers and another path in exploring the many different wines of the world.

**Viognier** - Viognier (VEE-ohn-yay) forms the base (along with Marsanne) of our Cotes de Tablas Blanc, as well as in some years providing an aromatic lift to our Roussanne-based Esprit de Beaucastel Blanc. Whether in the Esprit Blanc or the Cotes de Tablas Blanc, Viognier contributes intense aromatics of peaches, apricots, and violets, as well as viscosity and minerality in the mouth.

## New Beers

### **AVERY in the house...**

#### **"The Maharaja"**

Maharaja is derived from the sanskrit words mahat, - "great" and rajan - "king". Much like its namesake, this imperial IPA is regal, intense and mighty. With hops and malts as his servants, he rules both with a heavy hand. The Maharaja flaunts his authority over a deranged amount of hops: tangy, vibrant and pungent along with an insane amount of malted barley - fashioning a dark amber hue and exquisite malt essence. 9.8% ABV, 102 IBU

#### **"The Reverend"**

The Reverend, was created in tribute to the life of Sales Mgr. Tom Boogaard's grandfather, an ordained Episcopal Reverend. Tom was inspired by the life of his grandfather and wanted to create a tribute beer that contained his sterling traits. True to both our "small brewery, BIG BEERS" philosophy and to the spirit and character of the departed Reverend, this beer is assertive, and pure of heart, a heart of candy sugar. It contains as many authentic imported Belgian specialty malts as the brewers could cram into our mash tun, and lots of Belgian dark candy sugar stirred into the brew kettle. A divinely complex and beautifully layered beer with hints of dark cherries, currants, and molasses, complimented by an underlying spiciness and a finish that is Sinfully smooth!Cellarable for 4 years. 10% ABV, 10 IBU

#### **"Hog Heaven"**

This dangerously drinkable garnet beauty is a hop lover's delight. The intense dry-hop nose and the rich malt body are perfectly balanced for a caramel candy-like finish. This is a serious beer for serious beer afficianados and it only gets better with age. Cellarable for 3 years. 9.2% ABV, 104 IBU

#### **"Salvation"**

The success of HOG HEAVEN and THE REVEREND clearly demonstrates that beer drinkers are willing to embrace "BIGGER" beers. In the fall of 2001, we decided that a lighter BIG BEER would complement its darker colored predecessors. Salvation has luscious apricot and peach aromas delicately interwoven with spicy suggestions of nutmeg and cinnamon. This heavenly soft, champagne-like elixer is cellarable for 3 years. 9% ABV, 25 IBU.
