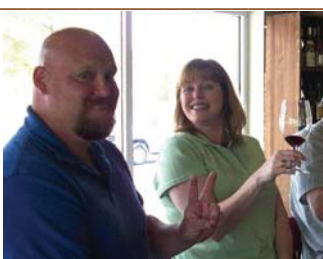

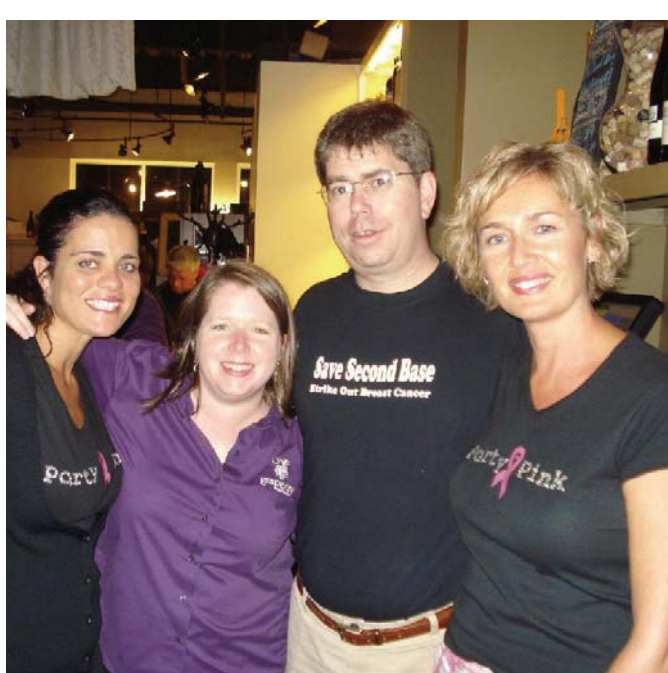

Pumpkin Ale**



Tis the time of year to start keeping an eye out for the tasty seasonals. Dark porters and stouts, spicy Christmas Ales, etc. are still a way off, but as

surely as the leaves will fall, the pumpkin ales are on their way. From my time tested source of info, Beer Advocate (www.beeradvocate.com) - Often released as a fall seasonal, Pumpkin Ales are quite varied. Some brewers opt to add hand-cut pumpkins and drop them in the mash, while others use puree or pumpkin flavoring. These beers also tend to be spiced with pumpkin pie spices, like: ground ginger, nutmeg, cloves, cinnamon, and all spice. Pumpkin Ales are typically mild, with little to no bitterness, a malty backbone, with some spice often taking the lead. Many will contain a starchy, slightly thick-ish, mouthfeel too. In our opinion, best versions use real pumpkin, while roasting the pumpkin can also add tremendous depth of character for even better results, though both methods are time-consuming and tend to drive brewmasters insane.

Currently, our Pumpkin Ale stock is limited to Weyerbacher Imperial Pumpkin Ale, but stay tuned, there are sure to be more.
